Abstract

The talk will cover 3 general areas: Irrigation Performance Assessment, Preventative Maintenance for Drip Systems, and Water Quality/Salinity Issues. The purpose of the discussion is to cover some pragmatic items for the grower to self-evaluate for the avocado irrigation systems. Discussion points will be made on the use of pressure compensated products and the important minimum pressure required for good performance. Also, water quality topics specific to irrigation system plugging will be covered.
