The use of Gibberellic Acid sprays to enhance fruit set

Gibberellic acid (GA) has been available for use on avocados in California under a special local needs (SLN) registration since March 2018. GA is used to enhance fruit set of avocados when applied at the cauliflower stage of inflorescence development. Additionally, GA can increase the size of the maturing crop. This talk will cover the details of application rate and timing of GA. Feedback from grower experience using GA will also be shared. Finally, the registration process will be discussed and what changes may be coming.
