AVOCADO VARIETIES REGISTERED IN 1953

Descriptions and other information about the following avocado varieties are based on data supplied by the registrant and on limited tests of the fruit— frequently involving a single specimen only. The information given here, therefore, is tentative and subject to revision as additional data are developed.

BEAVERS (Hybrid)

Originated at 10541 South Court St., Stanton, California. Seed from below Mexico City, 1938.

TREE—24 feet tall. Yield record, good.

FRUIT—Season: September to November; Color: green; Weight: 18 ozs.; Shape: pyriform; Skin: thick and smooth; Flavor: good

minus; Oil: 7.4%, September 30; Seed: 2 ozs.

BESSIE (Guat.)

Originated at 3756 Valley Street, Carlsbad, California, 1939.

TREE—Upright in growth. Record of production 1944, 4 flats; 1945, 8 flats; 1946, 4 flats; 1947, 2 flats; 1948, 22 flats.

FRUIT— Season: April to June; Color: green; Weight: 9 ozs.; Shape: pyriform; Skin: thick, smooth; Flavor: good minus; Oil: 13%, June 18; Keeping quality: not known; Seed: 1½ ozs.

BONDOSO (Hybrid)

Originated in orchard of P. L. Kovach at Vista, California, 1946.

TREE—Medium upright grower, good bearer.

FRUIT—Season: October; Color: green; Weight: 8 ozs.; Shape: pyriform; Skin: medium, smooth; Flavor: good plus; Oil: 13.5%, November 9; Seed: 1½ ozs.

CARTER (Guat.)

Originated on Ford property, Barsby St., Vista, California, 1948.

TREE—A strong grower. A heavy bearer. Not very hardy.

FRUIT—Season: October; Color: dark green; Weight: 133/4 ozs.;

Shape: pyriform; Skin: very thick and pebbled; Flavor: excellent minus to good plus; Oil: 13%, December 24; Keeping quality: fair; Seed: 2½ ozs.

DEWEY (Hybrid)

Originated at 527 East Commonwealth Ave., Fullerton, California. Grown from Fuerte seed, 1933.

TREE—Habit of Fuerte, but more vigorous. Yield record as follows: 1949, 250 lbs.; 1950, 50 lbs.; 1951, 275 lbs; 1952, 278 lbs. Hardiness: similar to Mexican race.

FRUIT—Season: late August through November; Color: medium green; Weight: 3 3/4 ozs.; Shape: pyriform; Skin: thin; Flavor: good plus; Oil content: 24.50%, October 30; Keeping quality: poor; Seed: 3/4 oz.

PEG (Guat.)

Originated on Jack Maechtlen property (Wild-wood Ranch), Glendora,

California, 1918.

TREE—Resembles Fuerte, but more upright. Average annual production 175 pounds.

FRUIT—Season: November and December; Color: light green; Weight 6 1/4 ozs.; Shape: pyriform; Skin: medium and smooth; Flavor: good; Oil content: 17.8%, December 15; Keeping quality: good; Seed: 1½ oz.

PONTEPRINO (Guat.)

Originated on ranch on Richfield road at Atwood, California, 1934.

TREE—Upright, 35 feet tall. Record of yield is good.

FRUIT—Season: May to October; Color: dark green; Weight: 12½ ozs; Shape: obloid; Skin: medium, smooth; Flavor: excellent; Oil: 18.40%, September 25; Keeping quality: fair; Seed: 1½ ozs.

REED (Hybrid)

Originated on property of James S. Reed, fifth row west of house, third tree on south side, 1948.

TREE—20 feet tall. Grows rapidly. 80 lbs. 4th year; 200 lbs. 5th year.

FRUIT—Season: May to September; Color: green; Weight: 12 ozs.; Shape: spheroid; Skin: thick and smooth; Flavor: good plus; Oil: 18.9%, July 29; Seed 3½ ozs.

SNYDER (Guat.)

Originated at 1636 North Vista Street, Hollywood, California, 1937.

TREE—35 inches around base of tree. Yield this year, over 200 lbs.

FRUIT—Season: June to November; Color: black; Weight: 18 ozs.; Shape: spheroid; Skin: very thick and pebbled; Flavor: good; Oil: 9.8 %, September 3; Seed: 3 ozs. Remarks: Looks like Queen.
